CASHEW	• Provide staking to nursery and young plants to avoid lodging, due to gusty winds and rainfall from 17th to 21st May, 2022 • Take precautions to avoid water logging in the fields • Land preparation for the new orchards can be done • A spacing of 7×7 m for normal and 5×5 for high density planting is recommended • Pits are to be kept ready at least ten days before planting

Horticulture Specific Advisory:

MANGO	• Due to forecast of light to moderate rainfall from 17th to 21st May, 2022 with isolated heavy on 19th May 2022, possibility of fruit drop, hence farmers are advised to harvest the 80 to 85% matured fruits and keep in safe places • Treat harvested fruits with hot water for 1 hr at 480 C to control fruit rot and also to kill the fruit flies eggs present inside • Provide staking to nursery and young plants to avoid lodging, due to gusty winds and rainfall on 18th, 19th and 20th May, 2022 • Take precautions to avoid water logging in the fields • Land preparation for the new orchards can be done • A spacing of 5 x 5 m is recommended in lateritic soil for high density planting system for Goa and Konkan region • After sun curing, the pits are filled with top soil, 1 kg rock phosphate, 1 kg neem cake, 10-20 kg FYM or compost • Pits are to be filled up to the brim and kept ready at least ten days before planting		
COCONUT	• Provide staking to nursery and young plants to avoid lodging, due to gusty winds and rainfall from 17th to 21st May, 2022 • Take precautions to avoid water logging in the fields • Land preparation for the new orchards can be done • In laterite soils pit size can be 1.2 m x 1.2 m x 1.2 m • Two layer of coconut husks can be spread at the bottom of the pit • The recommended spacing is 7.5 m x 7.5 m		
ARECANUT	• Provide staking to nursery and young plants to avoid lodging, due to gusty winds and rainfall from 17th to 21st May, 2022 • Take precautions to avoid water logging in the fields • Land preparation for the new orchards can be done • Pit should be half filled with top soil and 5-10 kg Farm Yard Manure (FYM) one week before planting
