Horticulture(Varieties)	Horticulture Specific Advisory	
MANGO	• In old mango orchard, center opening operation can be carry out which increase penetration of sunlight and result in increase in flowering and decrease in pest incidence • Due to cloudy weather and light rainfall there is possibility of incidence of hoppers on vegetative flush of mango, spray two rounds of Imidacloprid 0.2ml/lit of water • First spray at the time of panicle emergence, second spray two weeks spray	
CASHEW	• Due to cloudy weather and light rainfall, possibility of incidence of cashew stem and root borer and Tea mosquito bug. Hence take up the control measure when no rainfall • For Tea mosquito bug infestation, lambda cyhalothrin 5% @ 6 ml. Spray in 10 liters of water can be done • Remove dead trees and trees beyond recovery at least once in 6 months may reduce the spread of stem and root borer infestation. • Mechanical removal of the immature stages (grubs) of the pest during initial stages of infestation. • Treat the infested trees trunk region up to one meter height from the ground level and on exposed roots with Fipronil @ 2 ml in one litre of water or Imidacloprid 2ml/litre of water • If fresh infestation occurs repeat the treatment after 30-45 days.	
COCONUT	• Due to cloudy weather and light rainfall, possibility of incidence of but rot • Remove all the dead palms and palms beyond recovery • Spray 1% Bordeaux mixture to the crowns of the trees as a prophylactic measure for bud rot management when no rainfall • Apply 10% Bordeaux paste to the wounds / cu end. Cover the treated bud with protective covering till the normal shoot emerges during monsoon season for bud rot.	
ARECANUT	• Due to cloudy weather and light rainfall, possibility of incidence of fruit rot • Cover the areca bunches with polythene covers (125–200-gauge 24 x 30 inches) • Hence spraying of 1% Bordeaux mixture is recommended when no rainfall

COW	• Periodical application of acaricides in and around cattle shed is necessary for effective control of ticks • Farmers should approach veterinary hospitals in case of animals showing fever and coffee colored urine • Supplementation of Perrineal Napier grass, Subabul, and Moringa leaves with traditional feed for enriching the quality of ration. • Dry fodder like paddy straw and sorghum Stover may be enriched with urea or molasses and salt to enhance the digestibility in large ruminants

Poultry Specific Advisory:

Poultry(Varieties)	Poultry Specific Advisory
BIRD	• Deworming of backyard poultry with any broad spectrum deworming drug is advised before onset of winter as per veterinary advice and prevalence of parasitic diseases in the area • The moisture and quality of the litter materials in poultry shed need to be maintained to prevent coccidiosis infestation • Avoid water logging near the poultry houses to avoid flies/mosquitos and keep the houses dry and clean and well ventilated with weekly turning of litter materials
